Portage.

At Canton:

If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Ashland, Carroll, Crawford, Holmes, Richland, Stark,

Tuscarawas and Wayne.

At Youngstown: If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties of Ashtabula, Columbiana,

Mahoning and Trumbull.

At Toledo:

If the petitioner resides in or has his, her or its place of business in the counties or Allen, Auglaize, Defiance, Erie, Fulton, Hancock, Hardin, Henry, Huron, Lucas, Marion, Mercer, Ottawas, Paulding Putnam, Sandusky, Seneca, Van Wert, Williams, Wood and Wyandot.
