**Debtor Electronic Noticing (DeBN)**

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Ohio will provide all debtors with the option of receiving electronic notices effective January 1, 2018. Debtor Electronic Bankruptcy Noticing (DeBN) is a voluntary program that enables debtors to receive court-generated notices and orders through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center (BNC) via email. All other parties, including creditors, attorneys and trustees, must continue serving documents on debtors according to court rules.

Attorneys may request electronic noticing for debtors by docketing the Debtor's Electronic Noticing Request (DeBN) Form using the Debtor Electronic Noticing (DeBN) docket event in CM/ECF (under Bankruptcy, Other). Pro se debtors may request electronic noticing by submitting the Debtor's Electronic Noticing Request (DeBN) Form over the counter or via U.S. Mail.
